

Explore Your Call Workshop

Workshop Process

- Study: Great Commission & Ephesians 4
 - Lead a discussion about what the passages teach about God, Humanity, and Obedience.
 - Emphasize the following principles from these passages:
 - Every believers is called to ministry and mission
 - Some believers are called to ministry leadership to equip others for ministry and mission.
- Consider: How is God Calling You?
 - Place four large sheets of people on the wall or create four segments on a big dry erase board
 - Use the following category titles on the paper or dry erase board: Ministry | Ministry Leadership | Pastoral Leadership | Missions Leadership
 - Ask your congregation to place their names on the sheet they feel God is calling them to minister in.
- Assess: Spiritual Gifts tool with conversations around the table
 - Identify a spiritual gifts assessment for people to take.
 - Lead everyone to discuss their results in small groups and reflect on what gifts they see in one another.
- Identify: Next Steps
 - Encourage people to consider how their gifts and calling intersect with needs in the church or world around them.
 - Ask everyone to write down their name, calling area, spiritual gifts results, and a potential next step.
 - Follow up with these cards with other leaders in your church to mobilize those called to ministry and to begin discerning and developing those called to ministry leadership.
